Viognier, Domaine de Vedilhan, Pays d'Oc, France 2014

£23.00

Picpoul de Pinet, Villemarin, Languedoc, France 2015

£27.00

The Picpoul Pinet grape has lovely floral aromas with very lively, fresh fruit on the palate. Powerful and persistent, wonderful with fishy dishes. Also makes a great 'Kir' as an aperitif! Ask for a dash of cassis at the bar!

Chablis, la Colombe, France 2014

£38.00

Steely and powerful, a Chardonnay with a fresh bouquet, dry yet full of flavour that lasts on the palate.

Sancerre, Michel Girard, Loire, France 2015

£38.00

A delicate and complex Sancerre with great depth of fruit; the boisterous green aromatics often found in Sauvignon Blanc have been skilfully restrained, allowing fruity layers of apples and lemons to show through.

White Rioja, Camino Real, Spain 2014

£24.00

Interesting, complex wine of mouth filling flavours with hints of banana and date! We just love white Rioja its great with food and for sipping at the bar!

Albariño, Caixas, Spain 2014

£27.00

Fresh and balanced with pure flavours showing good mineral character and a good length and texture on the palate. Real Spanish class.

Sauvignon Blanc, Siegfried Old Coach Road, Nelson, New Zealand 2015

£34.00

Classic gooseberry on the nose with lovely balanced fruit flavours and a real mouthwatering finish. Just a little different from all the Marlborough's and in a good way too!!

Viognier, Alpha Domus 'Wingwalker', New Zealand 2012

£39.00

Typical of this variety. Wonderful expressive fruit with aromas and flavours of apricot and white peach. This is just divine! Worth treating yourself and sipping slowly.

Sauvignon Blanc, Cloudy Bay, New Zealand 2015

£48.00

Grown under ideal conditions. This is an elegant, aromatic wine with appealing fruit and crisp acidity. Cult NZ Sauvignon is the bees knees!

Chardonnay, Cloudy Bay, New Zealand 2013

£48.00

Intensely flavoured fruit, a sophisticated wine. Complex full bodied with ripe fruit and subtle smoky oak. One of our own favourites.

Chenin Blanc, Simonsig, Stellenbosch, S Africa 2015

£23.00

Aromas of sun ripe apples and pears transform to sweet dried apricots and honey on the tongue with a lovely mineral finish. S Africa own this grape for sure!!

Sauvignon Semillon, Simonsig, Stellenbosch, S Africa 2015

£23.00

Produced by Peter Malan, this wine has an attractive pale green appearance with a fragrant "grassy" bouquet and a crisp yet smooth dry taste. Beautiful wine from a classic blend.

Life from Stone, Sauvignon Blanc, Springfield Estate S. Africa 2015

£35.00

The grapes are grown on extremely rocky, calcareous soil and picked at night in the very low temperatures unique to this area. A wine of character and concentration, with a flinty black powder nose, a mineral palate and a delightfully complex finish. Give South African Sauvignon a go, there'll be no regrets!

Chardonnay, Methode Ancienne, Springfield Estate, S. Africa 2011

£50.00

This wine is made in the ancient style of Burgundy, rarely is this technique with wild yeast and no fining/filtration used in the new world. Oak-aged, the colour of sunshine, a wine to savour slowly, truly amazing!

Sauvignon Blanc, Casas del Bosque, Chile 2015

£28.00

Gentle gooseberry nose and not too up front. With mouthwatering gentle acidity this is a quality Chilean Sauvignon Blanc which would give many New Zealand wines a run for their money! Value for your hard earned money!!

Chardonnay, Casas del Bosque, Chile 2015

£28.00

Subtle use of oak ageing (6 months) gives this wine added complexity. Full in the mouth. Big, ripe, complex wine.

Gewurtztraminer, Miguel Torres, Chile 2014

£29.00

Wow, full of spicy flowers, lime and lychee on the nose! A real depth of flavour and richness of fruit, hint of spice and a nice acidity. We just love Gewurtztraminer, real food wine or just to quaff.

House Boat Chardonnay, Spee'Wah, Australia 2015

£24.00

Richly flavoured yet fresh! Notes of grapefruit, lychee & vanilla from French oak. Divine quaffing!

ROSÉ WINE

Santa Digna Rosé, Torres, Chile 2015

£28.00

Fragrant, floral and temptingly fruity. On the palate the wine is voluptuous with a silky texture full of fresh fruit, blackcurrant, cranberry and redcurrant that only Pacific Cabernet Sauvignon rosés can offer!

RED WINE

Côte du Rhône, Château St Roch, France 2014

Black fruit aromas with hints of leather and spice. Lovely full palate with a fine lingering finish. Very quaffable quality Côte du Rhône, small family vineyard!

The Cicada, Chante Cigale, Rhône, France 2014

The 'Singing Cicadas' from this Châteauneuf du Pape based producer bursts with raspberry on the nose and ripe cherries and a touch of spice in the mouth! This is mainly Grenache with a touch of Carignan to get you chirping!

Merlot, La Forge, Domaine Paul Mas, France 2012

One of the new innovative wine makers of France gives us blueberry, blackcurrant and red pepper on the nose with ripe fruit, smooth and round on the palate and leaving a warm glow to finish! Definitely not a Chilean Merlot!

Primitivo, Manduria, Surani Costarossa, Italy 2014

Dense ruby colour with aromas of dried prunes, dates, figs and sweet spice. Full and voluptuous in the mouth with toasty notes that linger on the finish. Pretty gorgeous actually!

Squinzano, Cantina Due Palme, Puglia, Italy 2013

From a blend of native Puglian grapes, Negroamaro and Malvasia Nero, a gorgeous bottle of vanilla, dark fruits and plum jam in this full, ripe and smooth wine showing little acidity.

Sassaiolo, Rosso Piceno Monte Schiavo, Italy 2013 Rich coloured blend of Montepulciano and Sangiovese grapes gives a wine that shows its age with rich, spicy aromas. Also with a big, rich mouthful giving way to great dry tannins and a hint of acidity.	£24.00
Aglianico, Tombacco, Campania, Italy 2013 From one of Italy's oldest wine regions comes the Aglianico grape. Known as the Barolo of the south it is deep ruby red with hints of cherry, vanilla and spice. Soft on the palate. Don't you just love Italy's variety!!	£24.00
Susumaniello, 'Serre' Salento, Puglia, Italy 2013 An unusual grape variety, Susumaniello was rescued from extinction by this winemaker. Rich and spicy it bears a likeness to Malbec and Carmenere wines from S America. We love it!	£33.00
Barbera D'Alba, Enzo Boglietti, Piemonte, Italy 2012 Beautiful, refined Barbera with nice spicy tannins and lovely proportioned freshness and fruit. One to save a glass to sit and savour after your meal, close your eyes and you're in Italia!!	£41.00
Ruit Hora, Bolgheri DOC, Italy 2011 Next door to Sassaccia but without the price tag!! This 'Super Tuscan' has aromas of ripe red berry fruit with cinnamon and liquorice. Complex flavours and dense tannins leave a lingering sweet finish on the palate, oh yes!	£48.00
Amarone Della Valpolicella, La Bastia, Italy 2011 The unique and wonderful Amarone! Corvina, Rondinella and Molinara grapes are picked in September and left to dry on racks until Christmas time. The resulting wine is rich, full bodied, velvety with raisin characters.	£60.00
Altano Duoro, Symington Estate, Portugal 2011 Lovely hints of rose petals and cranberries on the nose here! But the palate gives rich blackberry and raspberry flavours. Super taste of Portuguese grapes from a renowned Estate.	£34.00
Rioja Reserva, Vega del Rayo, Spain 2010 Vines are grown in distinctive stony soils ideal for the long even ripening of quality grapes. Richly flavoured and spicy this classic Rioja combines ripe plum and dried fruit characters with cinnamon and vanilla.	£30.00
Rioja, San Vicente, Spain 2006 San Vicente make Rioja the way they want to and this wine was served at the Spanish royal wedding! Brilliant red/black cherry colours of Tempranillo gives a wonderfully complex aroma, cacao and liquorice on the palate with hints of balsamic to finish. Mmm stunningly beautiful!	£55.00
Pinna Fidelis Roble, Ribera del Duero, Spain 2014 Juicy and smoky style made from Tinta del Pais grapes. Strawberry, raspberry and redcurrant on the nose with ripe black fruits, oaky vanilla and a touch of liquorice to taste. Great price for this style of wine, Ole!	£29.00
Château Musar, Gaston Hochar, Lebanon 2000/01 This is the 'one', it is more a wine of finesse, subtlety and refinement. It is quite astonishing that this now "world famous" red wine is produced at all, but to produce excellence is extraordinary!	£57.00
Old Vine Cinsault, Percheron, S Africa 2014 Not your usual Cinsault, this could be a top end Pinot Noir!! Earthy, minerality, red fruits, cherries and a hint of spice. This is drinking way above its price tag.. ch..ching!!	£20.00
Cabernet Merlot, Simonsig, Stellenbosch, S Africa 2013 A smooth rich red wine with ripe fruit and good structure. By wine maker James Malan at the family estate.	£24.00
Pinotage, Simonsig, Stellenbosch, S Africa 2014 A serious example of what can be done with this unique grape variety when in the right hands. It has a lovely aroma with hints of wood smoke, bramble fruit and freshly cracked nuts. The flavour is quite big and chewy with ripe fruit and a long "more-ish" finish.	£31.00
SMV, Simonsig Estate, Stellenbosch, S. Africa 2013 Shiraz, Mourvedre and Viognier are blended to give, in the words of Peter Malan (1 of the 3 brothers that are Simonsig) a 'Hammock Wine'. Intense flavours unlike anything you will have tasted before! Sip to enjoy.	£34.00
Shiraz, Simonsig, Stellenbosch, S Africa 2012 This wine shows classical Shiraz aromas of black pepper and saddle leather. Initially tight in the mouth the flavours then explode into an amazingly powerful finish.	£39.00
Tiara, Simonsig, Stellenbosch, S Africa 2011 A classic blend of Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot and subtle use of oak plus one of South African's best Winemakers. Result, a great wine?... no it's epic!	£40.00

Whole Berry Cabernet Sauvignon, Springfield Estate S Africa 2013 Cabernet Sauvignon grapes are harvested by hand, placed uncrushed in open tanks to ferment with natural yeast. There are no pumps or crushers. After racking, Whole Berry is matured in oak casks for 1 year. The result is a velvety wine, with soft tannins and classical varietal characteristics.	£40.00
Work of Time, Springfield Estate, S. Africa 2008 Icon of the Estate, hailed as a 'Petrus' of a wine!! This wine is a blend of 65% Merlot, 22% Cabernet Franc, 11% Cabernet Sauvignon, 2% Petit Verdot. The grapes are fermented whole with native yeast and left for 5 weeks on their skins, followed by a slow 18 month period of maturation; and a further 2 years of bottle ageing. A rich, smoky classic and complex wine of age, perfectly balanced.	£45.00
Zinfandel, Wente Beyer Ranch, California, USA 2011 Just elegant quality from this Zin! Ripe, round and with gentle spicy undertones and a big, long finish! Get in!!	£39.00
Petite Syrah, Suite Petite, Chronic Cellars, California, USA 2014 Dark, inky Petite Syrah with cigar spice aromas. Sweet cherries, juicy blueberries, brown sugar and spices on the palate finish with great tannins. This wine goes on and on. Bonkers label, worth checking out their range - mad!!	£42.00
Carmenere, Casas del Bosque, Chile 2014 Deep impenetrable colour - spicy, leafy nose - a big mouthful with loads of juicy fruit. Very drinkable indeed.	£28.00
Carmenere/Cabernet Sauvignon, Irene Morales Gran Reserve, Chile 2013 This is a big, elegant red wine - a real mouthful of flavour. Intense and complex with a huge, long finish! If you like really big, rich wines this has got your name written all over it!!	£30.00
Pinot Noir Reserva, Casas del Bosque, Chile 2014 One of the first Wineries to be established in the now highly renowned Casablanca region, Casas del Bosque is positioned amongst the pine forests and olive groves. This Pinot Noir has all the attributes that you would expect - elegance, accentuated, wild berry ripeness and firm acidity that gives freshness and length.	£33.00
Malbec, Pablo Cortez, Mendoza, Argentina 2015 Berries, plums, marmalade and cherries on the nose gives to intense, full bodied black fruits on the palate and sweet, soft tannins to finish. Lovely big Argentine Malbec for a great price!!	£25.00

Merlot Cabernet Sauvignon, Alpha Domus 'The Pilot' New Zealand 2012 This classic Bordeaux blend has a little Cabernet Franc and Malbec added to give even more fruit and structure. Again a stunning blend.. just quality!	£39.00
Shiraz, Wirra Wirra, The Good Catch, Australia 2013 Youthful, vibrant wine packed with raspberry, cherry and blackberry fruit and lifted with hints of violets and spicy oak notes. Originally made for The Oval cricket ground's hospitality hence the label!! Howzat!!	£27.00
